


🇬🇧 English Version – Physical Class Game – “Two-Sense Bucket Race” – Story 078



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Purpose of the Game,

Children learn to: cooperate, trust each other, develop respect and understanding for others

Materials

- 2 buckets, boxes, or bags per team
- small objects (blocks, balls, spoons, sponges, etc.)
- blindfolds

Preparation

1. Create teams of two children.
2. For each team place:
 - 1 bucket with objects (starting bucket)
 - 1 empty bucket about 4–7 meters away
3. Teams compete against each other.

Roles in Each Team

Player 1 – Blind: wears a blindfold, moves the objects

Player 2 – Cannot walk: stays in one place, may only help by talking and giving directions

How to Play the Game

1. The blind player takes an object from the starting bucket.
2. Player 2 gives directions using only their voice.
3. The blind player walks to the other bucket.
4. The blind player places the object into the empty bucket.
5. Then they return to get the next object.
6. Teams continue until all objects have been moved.
7. For the second half of the game, the players switch roles and bring the objects back to the starting bucket in the same way.

Winning: The team that completes the game the fastest after both halves of the game wins.
