

🇬🇧 Physical Class Game: Story 058: “Why can’t I inspire other students to be an example and be loved by everyone?”



### How to Play

1. **Circle of Actions**
  - Children sit in a circle. Each child picks one “action card” (examples: *help a friend, share kindly, speak truthfully, be patient, encourage others*).
2. **Act It Out**
  - Each child acts out their action silently (like a short mime).
  - Others guess what value the action shows (e.g., kindness, truth, discipline, love).
3. **Reflection Round**
  - After each act, the group discusses:
    1. Why this action inspires others.
    2. How it feels when someone does this sincerely.
4. **Joyful Twist**
  - The group votes for the “True Inspirator of the Day” — not the one who acted best, but the one who showed the most genuine heart and values.
  - Everyone claps and says together: “Real inspiration begins with love and values!”

### Moral Message

- True inspiration doesn’t come from gifts, looks, or achievements — it comes from sincerity, kindness, and living values.
- When we act with love and humility, others naturally feel inspired and loved.
