

🇬🇧 Physical Class Game: Story 054: “Finish with a Smile”



Setup

- Children sit together in a circle or small groups.
- The facilitator begins by reading the short opening of the girls’ story (grandparents who never went to school, grandchildren wanting to help them learn).

Rules

1. Add One Line
 - Each child adds just one joyful line to continue the story.
 - Example: “The grandchildren taught letters by singing songs.”
1. Pass the Smile
 - After speaking, each child gives a smile or clap to the next person before they add their line.
 - This keeps the game light and encouraging.
2. Happy Ending Together
 - At the end, the group decides on a short, positive message for the story.
 - Example: “Learning is fun at any age!”

Soul Blossom Twist

- The group chants together: “Every ending can carry a good message!”
- Optional: Children draw a quick smiley face or heart on a shared poster to symbolize their joyful ending.
