



Materials: Slips of paper with tasks (mix of “important” and “fun” tasks) and put them in box

How to play:

1. Divide the class into 4 teams:
 - Team 1: Fun first, important later.
 - Team 2: Important first, fun later.
 - Team 3: Joy + importance together.
 - Team 4: Learns and adapts.
2. Teacher draws 2 slips (e.g., “Do homework” + “Play football”).
3. Each team must act out the order the team-members would choose.
 - Team 1 might run to the “fun” corner first, shouting “Play football!” while pretending to kick a ball.
 - Team 2 might march to the “important” corner first, saying “Homework first!” with serious faces.
 - Team 3 must do both at once — maybe pretending to study while dancing or laughing.
 - Team 4 can copy another team’s style, showing they’ve “learned.”

Scoring

- The fastest team to act earns speed points.
- The funniest or most creative acting earns laugh points.
