



Setup

- Prepare ball cutouts (small paper circles) and window cutouts (rectangles).
- Write short values on the ball cutouts (e.g., *Honesty, Courage, Kindness, Responsibility*).
- Write joyful phrases on the window cutouts (e.g., *Well done! Good job!*).
- Place them in two baskets: Ball Basket and Window Basket.

How to Play

1. **Act the Story**
 - Teacher narrates the story step by step.
 - Children act out the roles: Malaika, Kito, and the neighbor.
 - When the “window breaks,” the class claps loudly to make the sound of glass shattering.
2. **Choose the Value**
 - After each scene, children pick a ball card and explain which value Malaika showed (e.g., honesty when she admitted the truth, kindness when she comforted Kito).
3. **Window of Joy**
 - For every correct value, the team earns a window card with a joyful phrase.
 - They stick the window cards on a big drawing of a house on the board.
4. **Compassion Circle**
 - At the end, children form a circle and pass a “ball of values” (soft ball or paper ball) while saying together: “Honesty and kindness repair every window with love!”
