- 7 “Someone breaks your things by accident.”

- 9 “Someone says you are wrong.”
- 10 “A friend gets a reward you wanted.”
- 11 “Someone interrupts you while speaking.”
- 12 “You feel left out.”
- 13 “Someone does not agree with you.”
- 14 “A friend forgets to include you.”
- 15 “Someone speaks louder than you.”
- 16 “You are asked to share something you like.”
- 17 “Someone accidentally bumps into you.”
- 18 “A friend chooses another partner instead of you.”
- 19 “Someone misunderstands what you said.”
- 20 “You have to do something you do not like.”
