

SSSSB Story 057b: Whom to Listen To? (for 10 years and older)



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There were two boys from grade 7.

Boy A:

"Sometimes I don't know whom to listen to. Grandparents say one thing, parents say something different, and friends tell me something else again. What should I do? Sometimes I feel confused about whom to follow."

Boy B:

*"I also have similar situations that confuse me.
My grandfather on my mother's side wants me to do a government job.

My grandmother on my father's side wants me to become a teacher.
My mother wants me to be a doctor.
My father wants me to be an engineer.
My friends want me to do something in sports.

What should I do? How can I make everyone happy?"*
