



Setup: Divide the class into 2 groups

- Write different values (e.g., honesty, patience, gratitude, discipline, service, love) on small cards.
- Hide these cards around the classroom or playground like “treasures.”

How to play: Treasure Hunt

- Each team searches for the hidden value cards.
- When a child finds a card, they must act out a funny mini-skit or funny example of that value.
 - Example: For *patience*, pretend to wait for a bus that never comes, making exaggerated faces.
 - For *honesty*, confess something silly like “I ate the last cookie... but it was invisible!”
- The rest of the group guesses which value is being acted out.

Sharing Circle:

- After all cards are found, children sit in a circle.
- Each team shares one real-life way they can use the values in school or at home.

Winning:

- There’s no “loser” — both teams win when they collect all the values.
- The prize: everyone shouts together, “New Beginnings with More Values!” and does a funny dance.
