



Materials:

- One pen or pencil (“Promise Pen”)
- Open space
- Happy music [or, someone sings] (optional)

How to Play:

1. Students stand or sit in a circle.
2. While music plays, they quickly pass the Promise Pen around.
3. When the music stops, the student holding the pen answers a quick question:

Examples: “How can you keep a promise?”; “What would you do if you forgot to return something?”; “Share one honest action.”

4. After answering, the student says loudly: “Even small promises matter!”
5. Everyone claps and the game continues.

Joyful Ending:

All students raise their hands and say together: “Small promises build big trust!”
