



Set Up

- The whole class plays together as one team.
- Prepare 3 Servant Cards:
 - Servant A: Helps only when someone is angry.
 - Servant B: Helps happily when asked.
 - Servant C: Looks for ways to help without being asked.

How to Play

- Pick Cards: Three volunteers - each picks one card secretly.
- Ask for Help: Someone from the class pretends to need help (e.g., dropping books, cleaning, carrying something).
- Act It Out: Each volunteer acts according to their servant style (A, B, or C) in a short, funny scene.
- Guess & Cheer: The rest of the class guesses which servant style each volunteer is showing. Everyone cheers for the one who shows the most joyful helping spirit.

Quick Reflection: Teacher asks: “Which servant style makes others happiest?” Children shout their answers together.
