



### Setup

- Children sit in a circle.
- One child is chosen as the Question Girl/Boy and holds a “magic microphone” (can be a pen, stick, or toy).
- A notebook or board to record answers.

### Rules

1. Ask the Big Question: The Question Girl/Boy asks: “*What is truly the most important thing in your life?*”
2. Pass the Microphone: Each child gives their answer when the microphone reaches them.
3. Note the Answers: The facilitator (teacher/guru) writes down the answers on the board.
4. Group Reflection: After everyone answered, the group discusses:
  - Which answers were similar?
  - Which answers were different?
  - What values do we see (love, health, harmony, learning, service, etc.)?
5. Soul Blossom Twist: Children vote or agree on 3 values they think are most important for building a happy, peaceful society.
