



**Setup:** Children sit in a circle. One child is chosen as the “Positive Leader” (they hold a small card or symbolic object). A board or notebook is available to record answers.

### How to Play

1. Think Round
  - The Positive Leader asks: “*What is one positive thought you can have today?*”
  - Each child shares a thought (e.g., “I can help my friend,” “I can be kind”).
  - Facilitator writes them on the board.
2. Say Round
  - The Positive Leader asks: “*Say one kind word to someone here.*”
  - Each child gives a compliment or kind word to another student.
3. See Round
  - The Positive Leader asks: “*What good do you see in others?*”
  - Each child points out one positive quality they notice in a classmate.
4. Do Round
  - The Positive Leader asks: “*What positive action will you do today?*”
  - Each child promises one action (helping, sharing, listening, etc.).

### Blessing Round (Joyful Twist)

- The group chants together: “*We think, say, see, and do positive things — for joy, peace, and love!*”
- Optional: Children can decorate a “Positive Tree” poster by adding leaves with their thoughts, words, qualities, and actions written on them.
