- 6. I try to look good, but that also didn't inspire others to see me as an example or make me more loved by anyone.

What should I do more? How can I inspire everyone and be loved by everyone? Nothing I try is working."

The students decided first to listen to the experiences and advice of the SSSSB members, and with that knowledge and inspiration, try to find new ways to be inspirations and loved by everyone.
